Currently there are about 250 priests that serve as chaplains in our military, but the need is far greater than that. To adequately staff and support our military over 800 priests are needed to serve as chaplains. Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, at the Supreme Convention in Denver, announced a new initiative for the Knights of Columbus to support priestly vocations for the military. The Knights of Columbus have established a new military chaplain scholarship, reserved exclusively for seminarians who will, once ordained, serve both their home diocese and the Archdiocese for the Military Services as a uniformed chaplain. The goal is for the 4th Degree Knights of Columbus, as the patriotic arm, to raise \$5 million over the next five years.

Sacred Heart Assembly has pledged to raise \$1,000 as our contribution. A \$5 assessment was voted on and approved at our October meeting. This voluntary assessment will continue until our goal is met. If all members participate we can make our goal in the first year. This is a great way to support vocations and our troops at the same time.

Although a copy of the ammended By-Laws has been found in the minutes of the Assembly, there were some questions brought up about some sections being in compliance with the Supreme By-Laws. Therefore, I have formed a new By-Law Committee to go over the amended By-Laws to make sure that they

are in compliance with the Supreme By-Laws and to formulate any new amendments as they deem necessary. The appointed committee is Tony Vittorini, Cliff Wasmund, Bill Konyvka, and Paul Palka led by Larry Frontera.



On October 15th we visited the John Dingel Veterans Hospital in Detroit and held a bingo for the patients. Thanks to all that turned out. The next trip to the VA Hospital will be April 28th.

2012 Assembly Dues

It is that time of year when you will be receiving your billing for 2012 Assembly dues. You should be receiving that notice within the next 2 weeks.

This year, there will be a change for many of you as to how you receive your billing. As a result of a Supreme Council Member system which our Assembly is now using for maintaining our member information and accounting, an email bill will be sent to your email address of record. The "Subject" of the email will be, "1st Notice from Assembly 2599." It will contain an attachment, in PDF Format, and contain all billing information, including 2012 dues and any voluntary contributions as approved by the Assembly. Please open the attachment and print it. When submitting your payment, detach the top portion of the bill, (there will be a perforation line across the top portion), and return it with you payment, whether you mail it, or bring it to the meetings. If it applies, note any changes you may have to your address, phone number or email. For those members with no email address on file, a notice identical to the email attachment will be mailed to you. Follow the same instructions noted above. If you wish to receive your future Newsletters, and communications via email, please note your email address on the top portion of the bill with your payment.

By using email for this and other correspondence, a significant amount of money is being saved by eliminating the use of stamps, envelopes, and printing supplies, thereby making better use of our dues and operations money for charities and the good of our Assembly.
